Short-term commitment

- Update Bike to Work Day website

- Organize a "bike train" (adults and students riding together to school) with the Thomas Harrison Middle School PTO for National Bike to School Day | **May 8, 7:30am** | *one hour service*
- Bike to Work Day Breakfast – May 17
 - Set up (6am-7am hrs)
 - Greet riders and keep area clean (7am-10am hrs)
 - Clean up (10am-11am)
- Co-lead a short neighborhood ride – date: tbd (2 hrs)
